Kimbrook House, Cambridge

Extension and glass links to a grade II listed House

Located within Cambridgeshire is Kimbrook House, a detached grade II listed dwelling. The clients were looking for sympathetic design that enhances the existing setting and neither detracts or overpowers from it. The proposals for this scheme were not to extend the listed structure, but create a semi independent structure away from it. A single storey family room extension has been carefully placed away from the key historic facades, this ensured minimal disturbance to the historic fabric and setting; allowing the listed structure to remain dominant in scale and presence. The use of glass links allows visual separation while creating a flow between the listed building and extension.
